2020-2021 School Options Pre-Kindergarten – 12th Grade

During this time when parents are faced with many decisions for their students' learning, we want to offer as much assistance as possible. The following are options available at AHSJ. A web form will be available on the Parent Portal so you can select the option that works best for your student. Should you need to change it at any time during the school year, simply contact the office.

In-School Learning

- All programs will operate with all students on campus.
- Lower school classes will work mostly in their classes with continued extra-curricular classes from specialists.
- Lunch times will remain the same, with some classes possibly eating in their rooms.
- Teachers will use technology to simulcast classes to students following from home.
- All teachers (PreK-12th) will use FACTS LMS to communicate with in-person and distance learners.

Hybrid Learning – On and Off Campus

- All programs will operate on campus and students will choose to attend half-days or every other day.
- Students will attend core classes on-campus.
- Teachers will use technology to simulcast classes to students following from home.
- Students will be provided with materials/instructions for classes where students are participating from home.
- Some classes will be self-study, with assignments being turned in to the teacher, as they are not conducive to live-learning (choir, PE, keyboarding, etc).
- All teachers (PreK-12th) will use FACTS LMS to communicate with in-person and distance learners.

Distance Learning

- All programs will operate with all students on campus and distance learning students will be expected to login for class at the appropriate times.
- Emphasis will be placed on students attending live core classes (math, science, language arts, and history), as well as additional classes for middle and upper school students.
- Students will be part of the "class" through a regular Zoom login, and expected to participate when asked.
- Study materials will be provided through FACTS LMS unless otherwise requested by the teacher.
- Some classes will be self-study, with assignments being turned in to the teacher, as they are not conducive to live-learning (choir, PE, keyboarding, etc).
